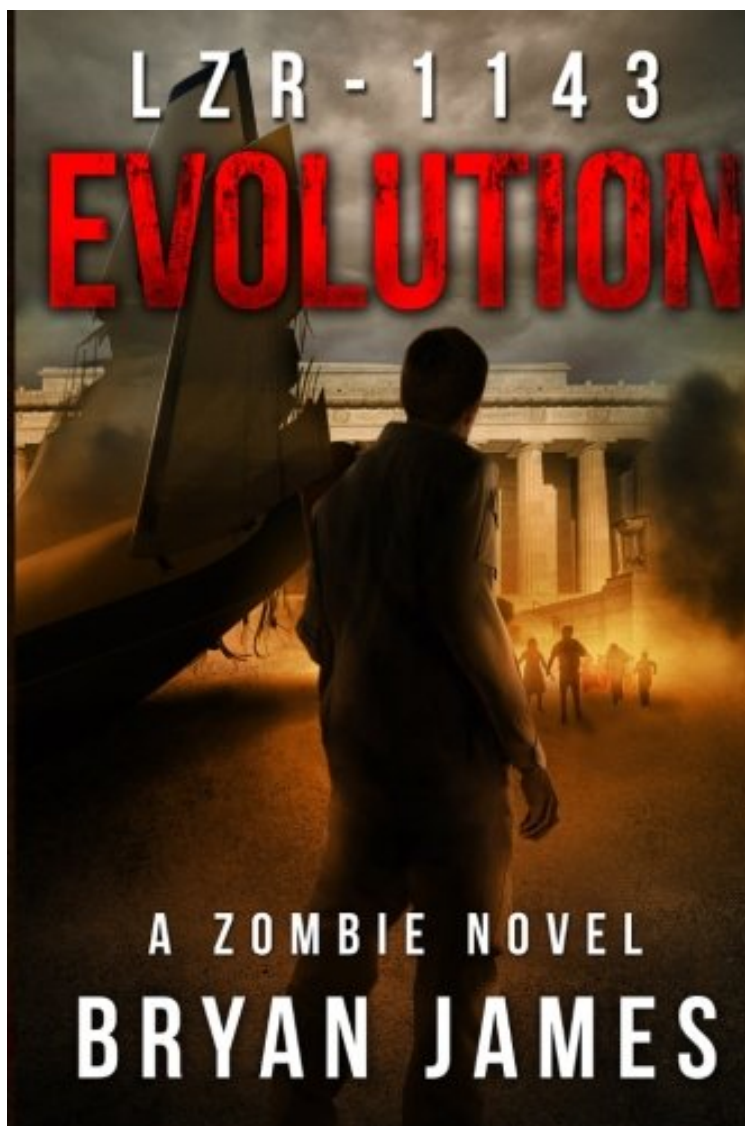

American literary tradition - but it will keep you turning the pages! It's got the zombie tropes you crave (if like me you crave such things) and the gore and stench descriptions are... juicy... in the best I-just-stepped-on-an-avulsed-eyeball-in-the-dark sort of way. While there are almost as many miracle saves by helicopter as the first novel in the series, the author is improving at finding ways to get his characters out of a jam. The characters gain some depth and develop. The group expands, becomes more interesting, and is joined by one or two mascots (depending on your point of view). Likeable characters do die, which is a plus in a zombie tale. This was a step in the right direction. Things that detracted from the book for me included: really bad science (bad enough that it could just as well be magic), coincidental coincidences, predictability, and really bad science. Bottom line: fast moving enjoyable zombie stuff with the themes and motifs you will recognize from across the zombie genre. Not hugely original but fun nonetheless. Most exciting thing about this novel was to see the author develop.
