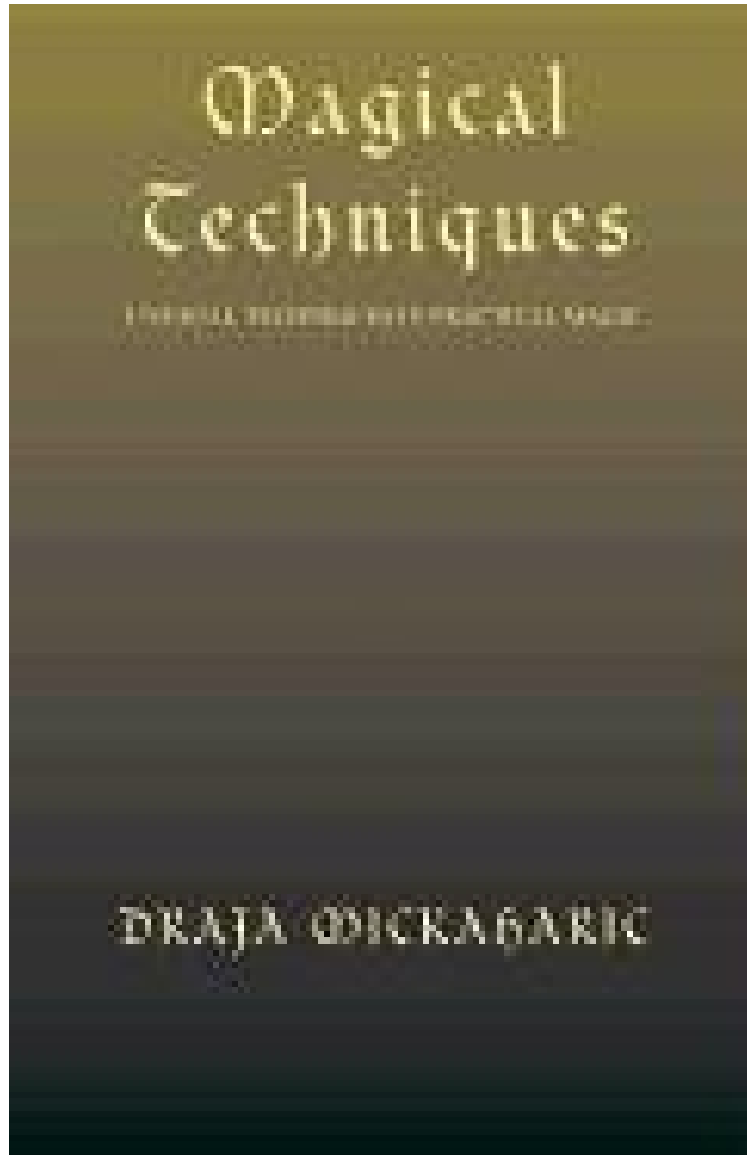

traditional African religion that requires many years of study and initiations in a spiritual house and under a madrina/padrino. It is great to learn more about this religion, but some of the ways in which to collect different wood sticks, or palos, from my understanding is reserved for the initiated palero or palera, not the everyday person. I may be mistaken in this, but I would recommend that a more specific and concise title be given to this book since its primary focus centers around the practices of Palo.
