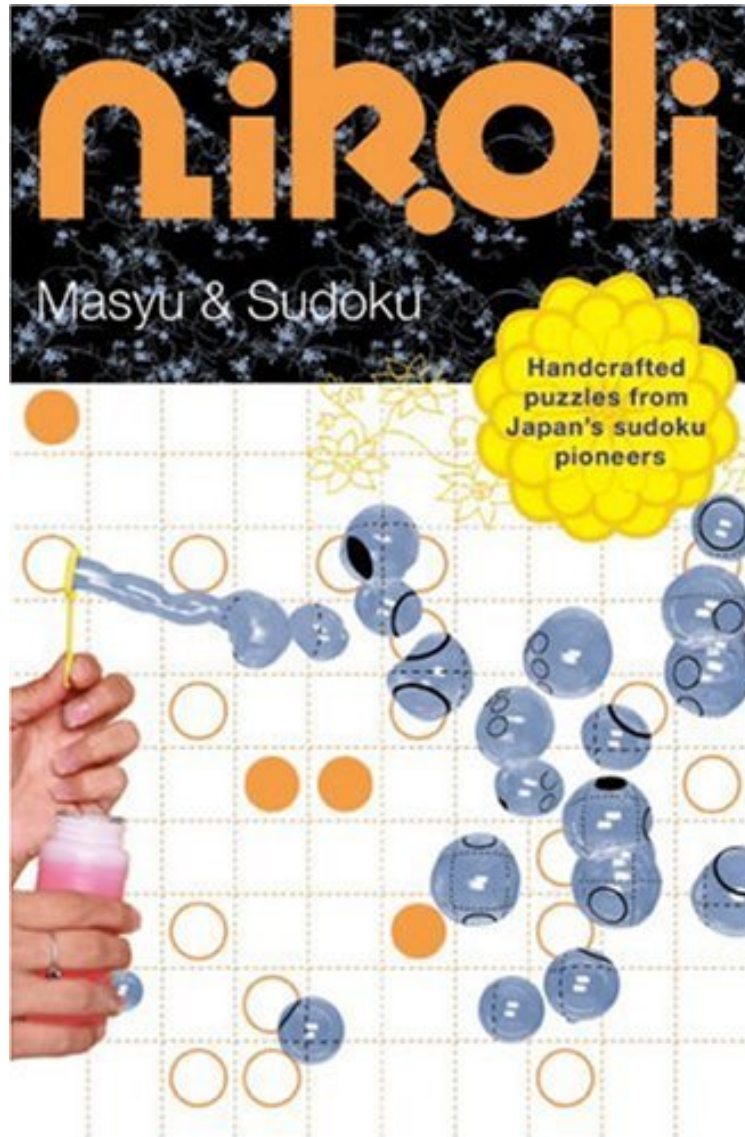

I am an unabashed sudoku fan who is always looking for other addictive logic puzzles. Nikoli produces human-made (rather than computer-made and human-checked) logic puzzles. Their sudoku are elegant and interesting. If you have never tried them, you should.
Which got me to this book. I wanted some Nikoli sudoku to work on and masyu sounded very interesting. I'm not going to explain all the rules (there are only 3, but they take some time to clarify) -- you can go on Nikoli's web site and explore them. The point is, I wanted to try masyu, and getting some excellent sudoku in the same book was the excuse I needed to try some.
Like most logic games, masyu are fairly simple at the "easy" level, and can be hellish at the advanced level. I found them quite addictive, and enjoyed solving even the ones that were too hard for my level of experience.
The beauty of the book is that it is a no-lose proposition for someone who likes sudoku and wants a taste of a different type of logic puzzle. Even if you decide you do not like masyu that much, the experiment was probably worth the price of the book.

Already have Slitherlink and Masyu, and didn't really need yet more Sudoku, but these are not-to-be-believed puzzles. They revolve around teaching themes that make you a better thinker in their peculiar ways. Get one!!

Connecting these puzzle cells involves using your brain cells to the max! Masyu features a series of black and white circles arranged in a grid; the object is to join them in a single, unbroken loop with a line that passes through every circle. Of course, there's a twist: there are special rules about how the line may make 90-degree turns when it passes through a black or a white circle. It's like a maze with no walls, and there's only one solution to find it!
In addition to the 90 masyu, there are 45 sudoku, too.
