This book is for the very strong intermediate and advanced player and deals with important issues not covered in standard books on bidding and play of pairs match point scoring.Of particular importance so far are the sections on playing a 4-3 fit, when to bid one no trump with a 5 card major and more importantly when not to bid one no trump with a 5 card major. He also covers penalty doubles, and again Woolsey gets right to the heat of the matter of how and when and when not to make them. There is little good written information on low level penalty doubles other than "Welding the Axe" by Boehm, so this section is one of my favorites.This is a book that will be read and then reread several times.My favorite bridge author is Mike Lawrence and this is as good as his books.
