Even at those rare moments when the music appears not quite so excruciating technically, there are endless harmonic and melodic nuances to take into consideration. Fast, furious, and often

seemingly impossible, even the best of pianists have trouble with the genius that is Liszt. That said, this book is my absolute favorite.
