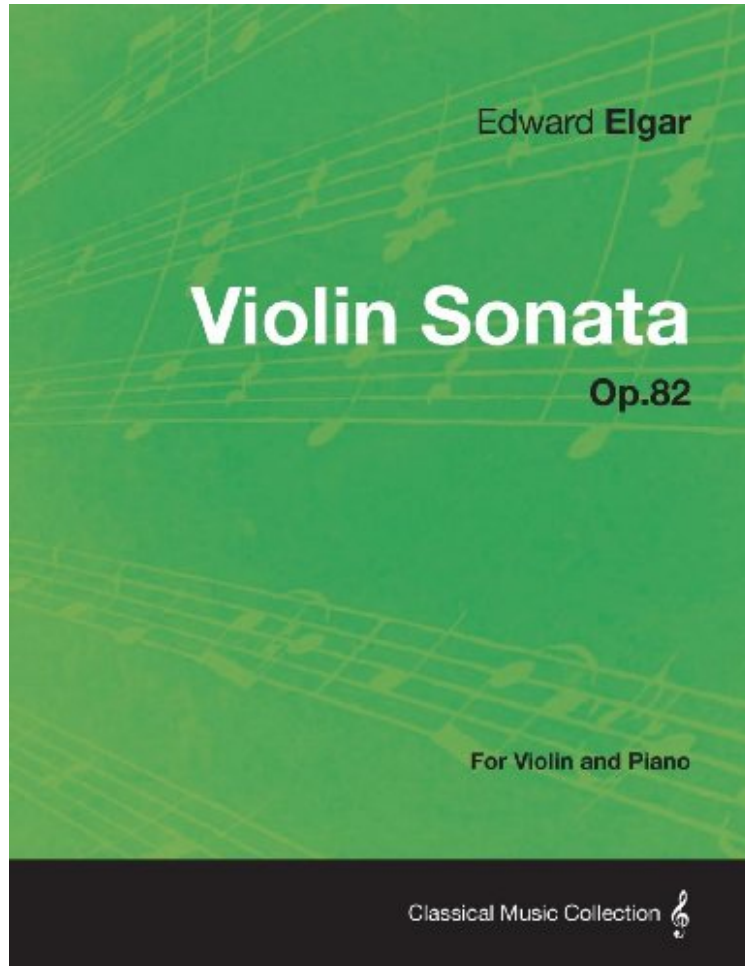

Haugtussa Op.67 is a sonata for voice and piano composed by Sir Edward Elgar in 1918. It contains three movements: Allegro. Risoluto, Romance. Andante, and Allegro non troppo. Sir Edward William Elgar (1857-1934) was a popular English composer during the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. His most famous works include Enigma Variations, the Pomp, and Circumstance Marches. Many of his compositions are now an integral part of the British and international classical concert repertoire. Elgar is considered to be the first composer to make proper use of the gramophone, and appointed Master of the King's Musick in 1924.
