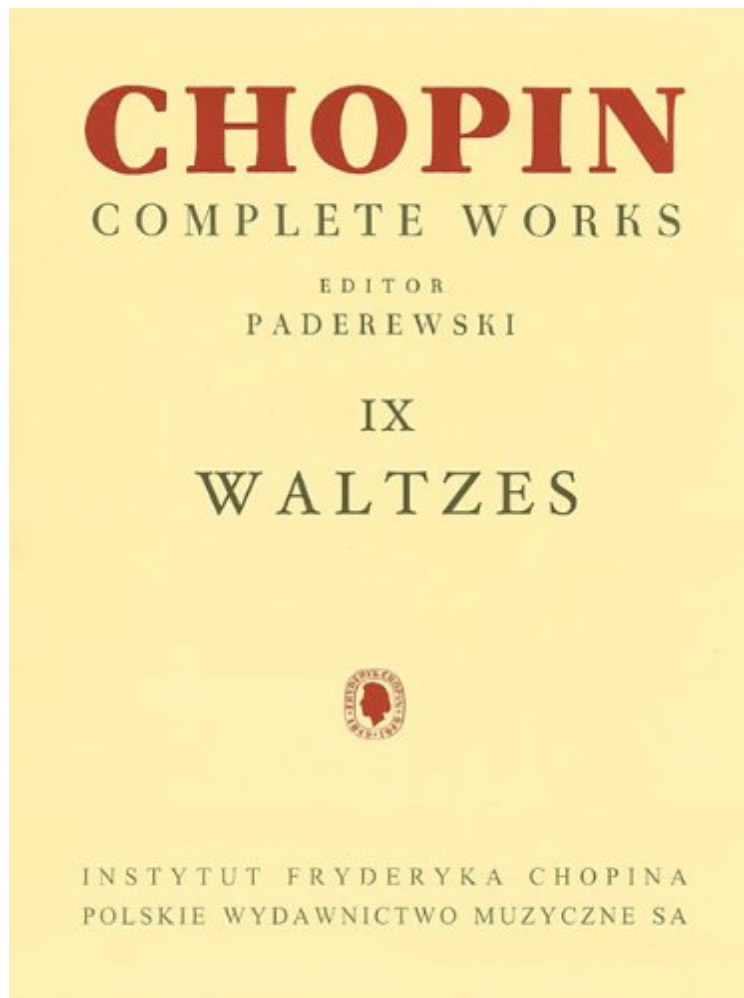

Any recordings before Jan 2013 will be based mostly on Paderewski and thus this edition is still useful. The only complaint is the binding (glued!) and thus it cannot stay open flat.
