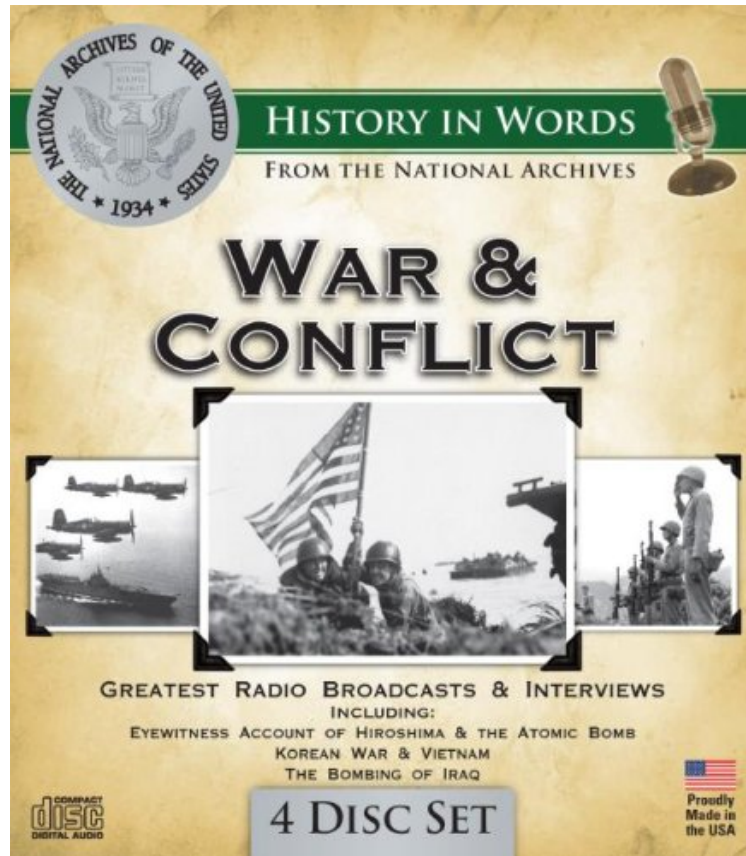

The subtitle for this collection is History in Words - From the National Archives. Topics Entertainment markets this item. On this 4-disk collection are actual historical audio recordings from the National Archives. Some of the selections are formal speeches to the Nation by Presidents and dignitaries. Several selections are on the scene combat recording by reporters or military combat reporters. There is no apparent sorting of recordings by conflict - WW2 - Korea - Viet Nam. In fact quite a mix of conflicts covered. Topics Entertainment has put together several of these quite interesting sets. One of the most curious recordings is a 16 minute recollection by Confederate General Julius Howell recorded when he was 101 in 1947! He is very articulate and it was a real pleasure to hear his thoughts on the war. I am a student of the Viet Nam

conflict so I was particularly interested in her General Westmoreland's report to congress in 1967 (30 minutes) and Nixon's address to the Nation on the war in 1969 (32 minutes). This unabridged audio book collection is recorded on 4 compact disks. The disks are secured in standard CD holders and packaged in an external cardboard box. A highly recommended audio collection that provided this listener with many hours of entertainment and education.
