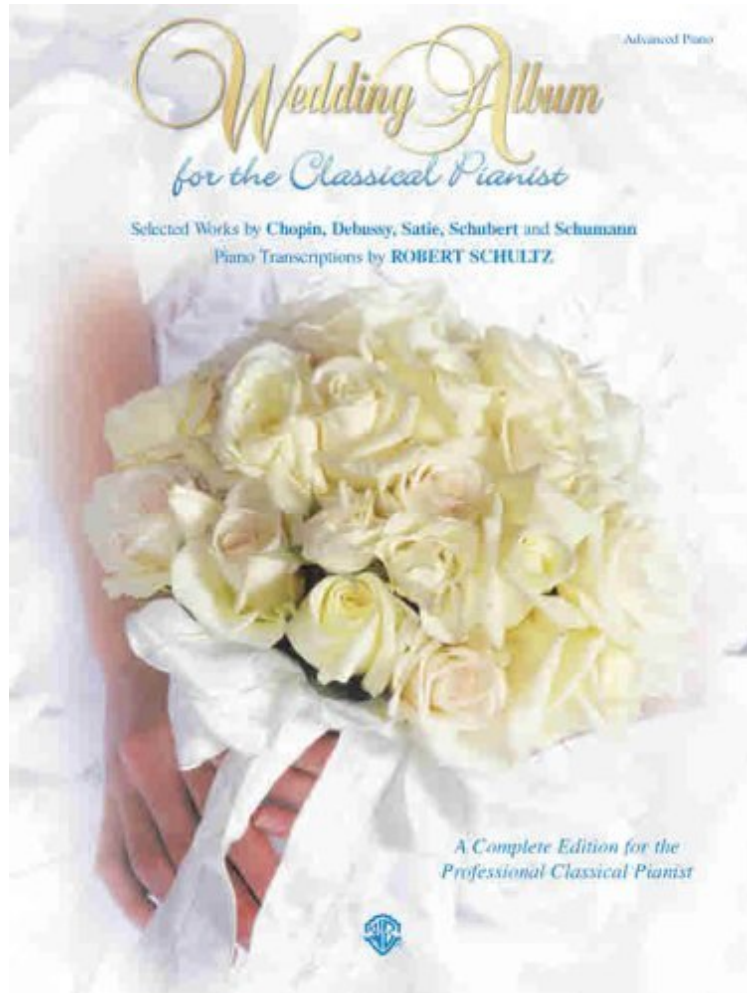

It's a good collection of wedding pieces, that is so useful as I have a number of wedding music to plan.However, the disappointments for me are: one, that Robert has edited some of the popular traditional wedding pieces like the Wedding March to a simplified and much shorter version. It seemed to lack the intricacy and richness that these classical pieces had.
