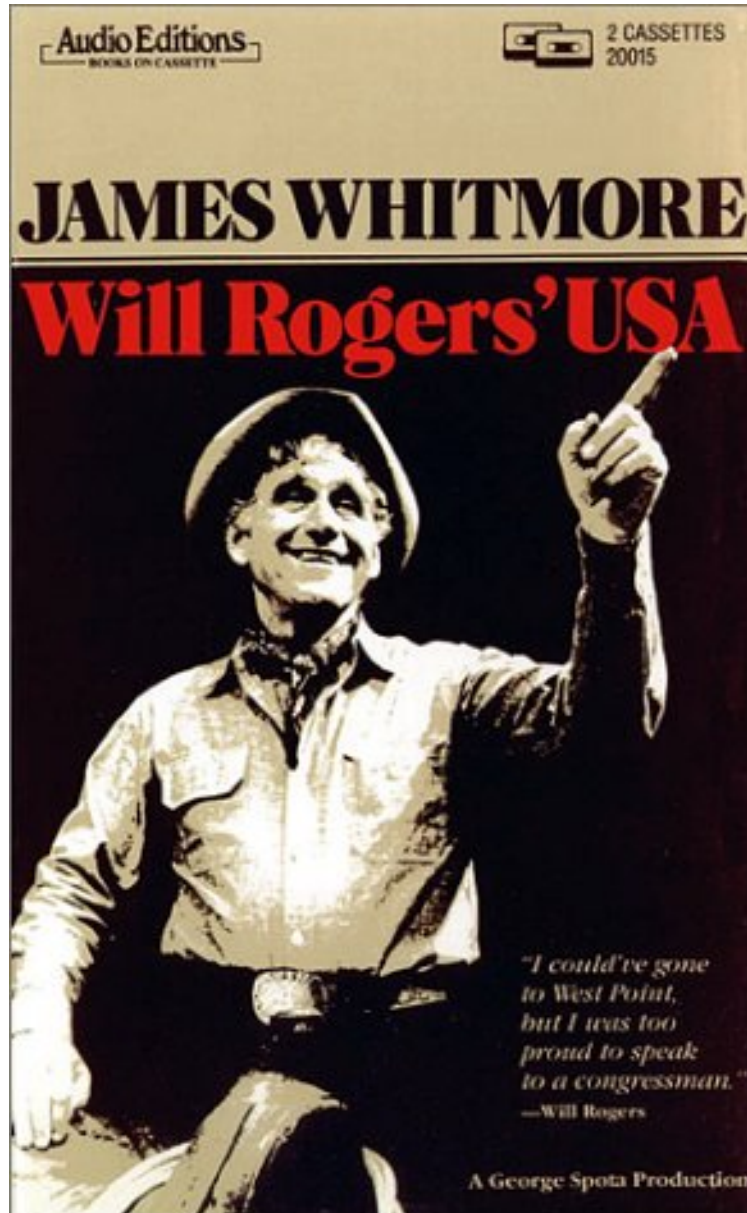

As a Will Rogers biographer and former director of Oklahoma's Will Rogers Memorial Commission, I heartily endorse James Whitmore's incredible one-man triumph as "Will Rogers USA." When Whitmore premiered his show at Ford's Theatre, I watched with awe. Thirty years later, at Ford's Theatre, I watched his swansong performance with enriched awe. Standing beside Whitmore, I saw tears flow down James Whitmore's rugged face as we stood on the hillside above the place where, in 1935, Will Rogers died along with aviation guru Wiley Post when their small plane crashed. My tears flowed too. Then, after flying from Point Barrow to Fairbanks, my wife Michelle and I again saw James Whitmore in his most powerful of all the dozen or more performance we had witnessed. The last time we watched Jim, was on the tiny stage at the Claremore, Oklahoma museum. He always was magical to the end. Some great actors have played Will Rogers both in one-man shows and in the award-winning Broadway musical, "The Will Rogers Follies." Whitmore, Larry Gatlin, Keith Carradine and even Will Rogers Jr. have assumed the role of that great cowboy humorist Will Rogers. Even I produced and performed my own one-man show for 180 performances in Branson, Missouri. We all tried our best to understand the man and project his inspiring wisdom. For three decades, the late and mourned James Whitmore played "Will Rogers USA" that fortunately now is available on .com. May it last eternally.
