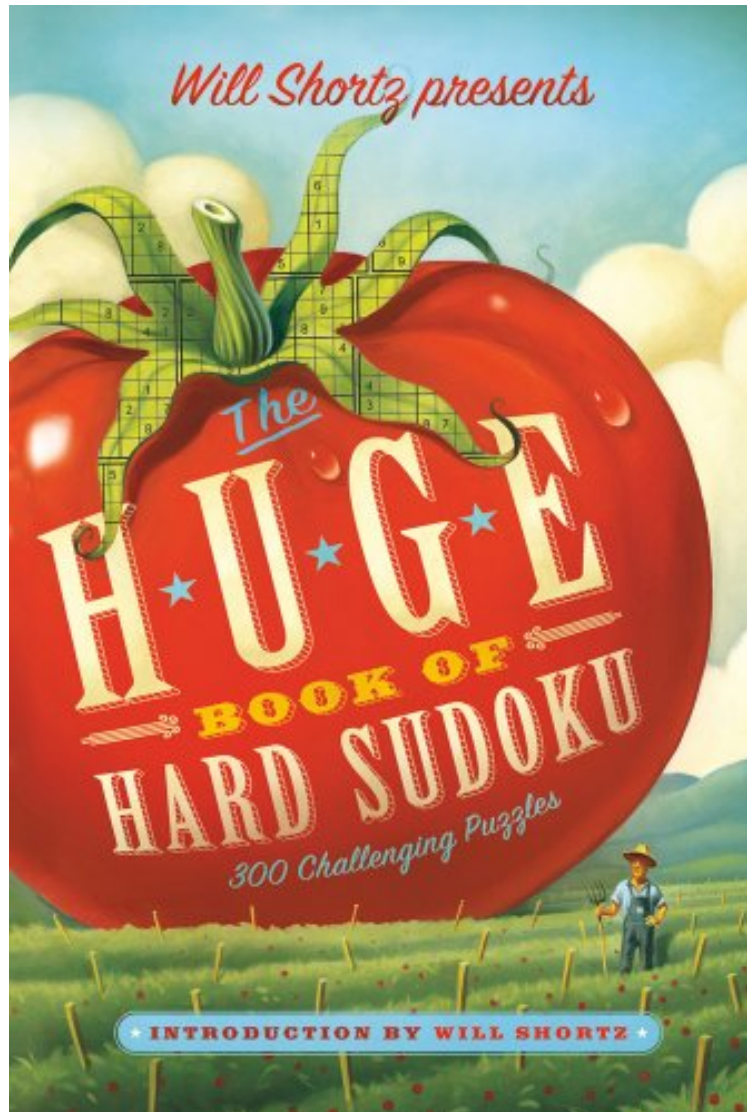

Grids are not huge. By gilbert richmond Huge Book of Hard Sudoku Puzzles, is not huge. The book is about 6 inches by 9 inches. The puzzle grids are about 4 and a quarter inches wide by about 4 and a half inches long. If you have an incredible memory and don't need to write in candidates when doing hard sudoku, this book may be okay for you. But I'll need to use a printer to reproduce these puzzles into a larger format if I'm going to do them. I prefer hard and very hard sudoku and these are the degree of difficulty I like, but reprinting each puzzle isn't worth it. If you want a large print sudoku, I suggest 'Large Print Sudoku #4 by Frank Longo. The puzzle grids are about 6 and a half inches by 6 and a half inches. With a one thru 4 star rating for difficulty. The 4 stars are very hard with occasional X wing problems. The 1 stars are easier.
