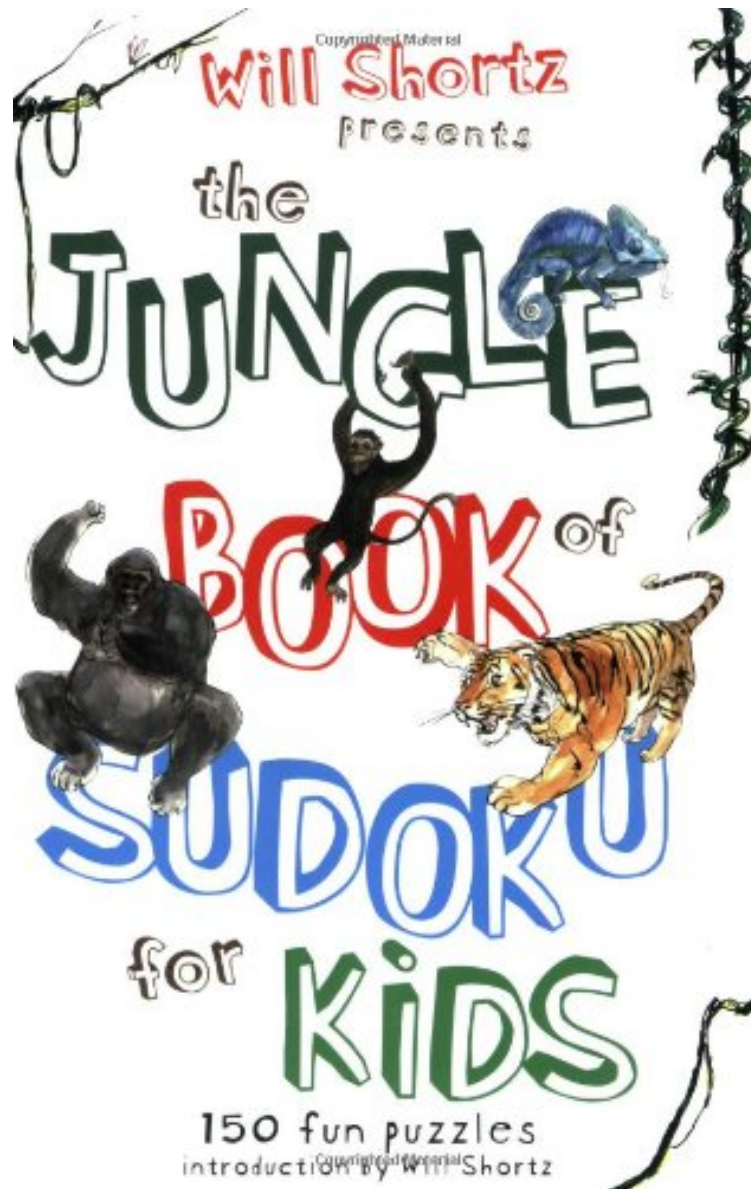

My seven year old daughter was interested in learning how to do Sudoku puzzles, and this was the perfect way for her to learn. To give you an idea, the "easy" puzzles in the first section were about the right level for my seven year old beginner. The "moderate" ones are challenging for her, and the harder puzzles are too hard for her to complete.
