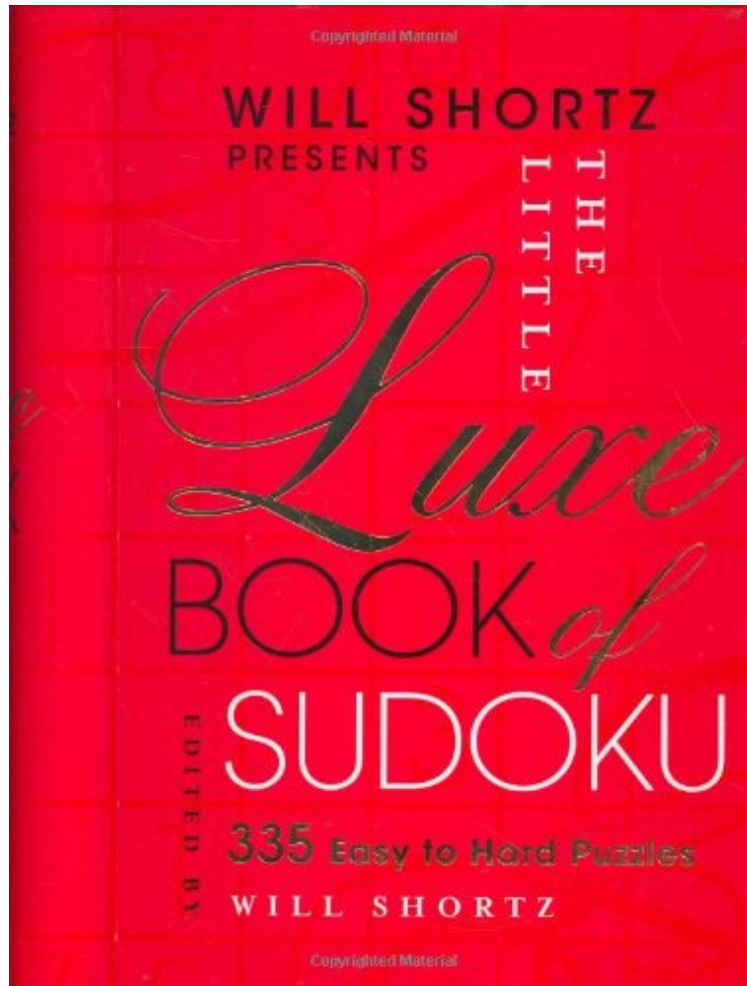

The easy puzzles are closer to the average medium puzzles and the moderate are a bit harder than the usual medium, making it perfect for someone like me who doesn't like the clutter of having to enter 4 or more numbers in squares to solve. There are still plenty of hard ones for the experts. There are roughly 90 puzzles each of easy, moderate, demanding and very challenging. There's one puzzle to each 5x7 page, making it easy on the eyes. The pages are thick and easily take the punishment of plenty of erasing without going thru the page. I've got one puzzle I've had to erase

everything and start over 3 times and the paper is still not worn. 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful. Excellent for beginners who want to work their way to more challenging puzzles. By Long Beach Native I like this book because the puzzles are one/page so there is plenty of room to write in each small box. For better or worse, the puzzles range from very easy to somewhat challenging. The hardest puzzles don't require any special techniques such as swordfish or x-wing -- they just require patient logical elimination based on the fundamental rules of Sudoku. If you know, for example, that if two squares in the same row, column, or box are the only two that contain a given pair of numbers (such as 2 and 5) -- that ONLY a 2 or 5 could go in each of those two squares -- that's about all you need to know to solve the most difficult puzzles. Also, oddly, these puzzles are not symmetrical. It really doesn't detract from the fun, but I always thought that was a requirement for Sudoku. If Mr. Shortz would write a book that had *only* the most challenging puzzles in this book, and maybe some that are more challenging, I would be very happy to buy it. But for me, only about 15% of this book is any fun at all. Also, even though it is spiral bound, it doesn't fold back on itself as easily as a typical spiral-bound book. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
