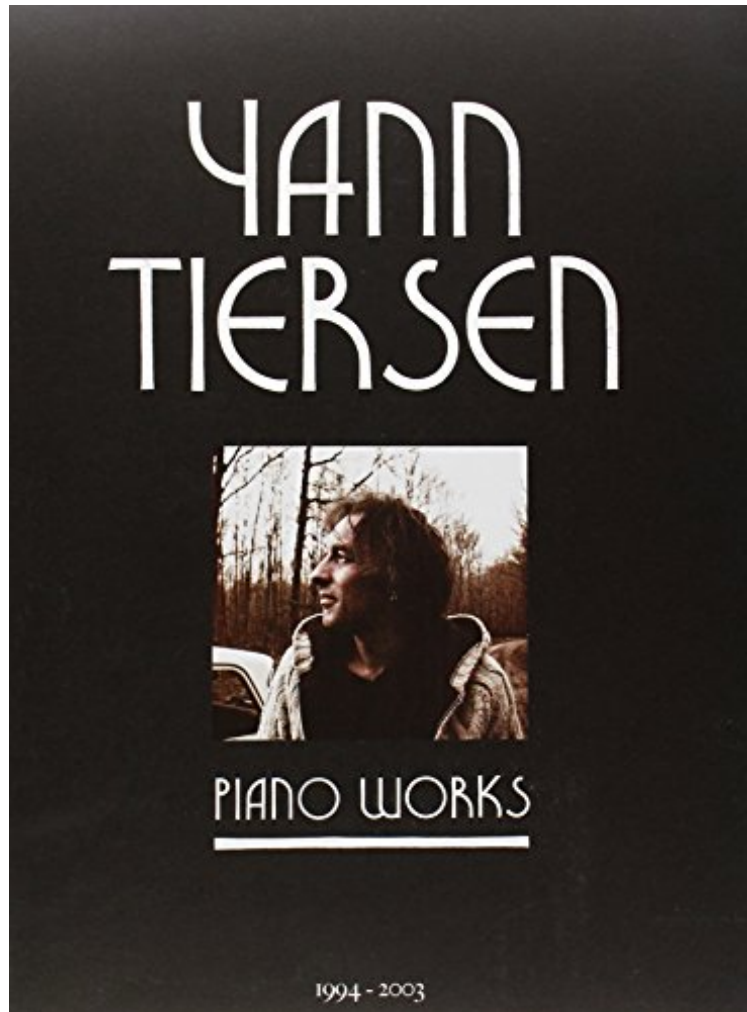

I fell in love with the music and had to learn it myself. I am very pleased with this book except I am not thrilled with what I think was a stylistic choice on the part of the publisher to make the print very light and small. On aging eyes this is not a good thing. I have many piano works of comparable and higher difficulty levels in which the notes are much easier to read.The music isn't particularly difficult - I would classify it as

early intermediate - but a lot of the pieces require a fairly significant finger span so small hands will not be able to play these pieces. 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful. Great book! By duckwhisperer I love this book. I'm not the best pianist. It takes me a long time to learn a song. Tiersen's music is repetitive and that makes it easier to learn. This book has easy songs (easy if you're somewhat experienced) and more difficult songs. They're all beautiful. My one complaint is that as I was listening to some of the songs off YouTube deciding what I wanted to learn first the music is not always exactly the same. But it would be easy to write in the changes or improvise if you wanted it to be exactly as you heard it. Otherwise they're still beautiful songs to play as written. 7 of 7 people found the following review helpful. Great music well notated! By eTrips I was hoping that the written music was at least close to the performance version by Yann himself. And this is! Right on the money! It's all there to learn...all you need to add is your own expression and tempo modification if you wish. Nice book!
