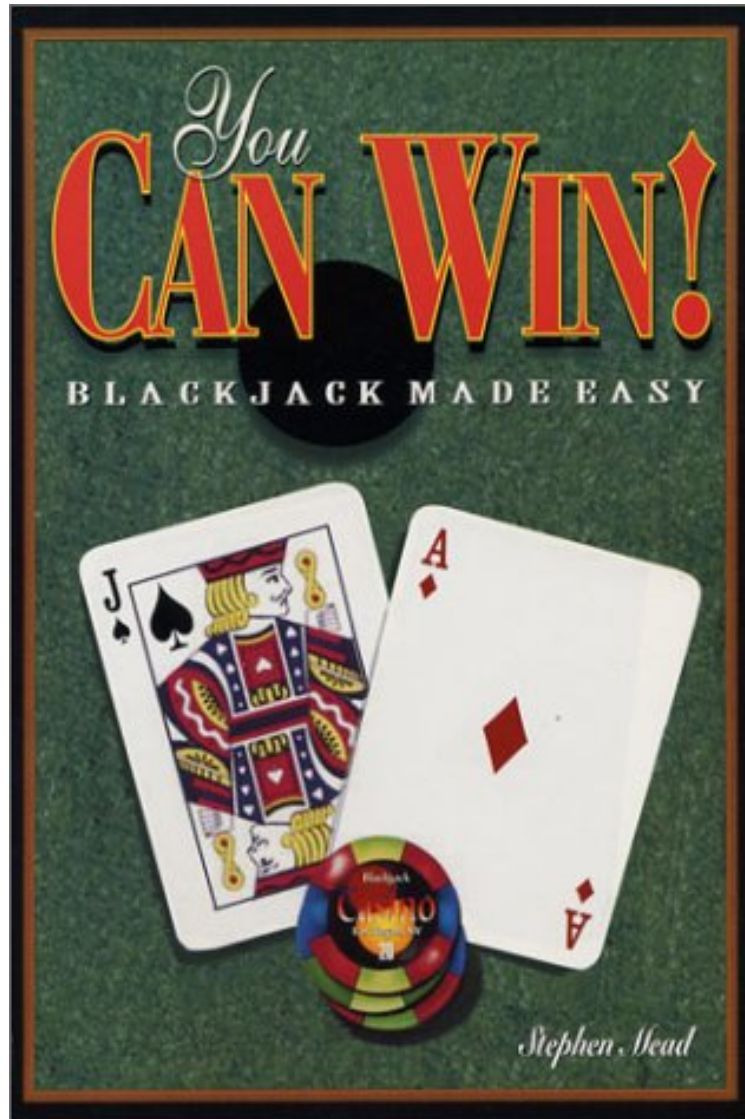

Most are complex and in-depth, containing many confusing graphs and charts and packed full of facts, figures, percentages, and other overwhelming information that even a rocket scientist would have trouble understanding. Most of this information you never need. You don't have to know why you hit 16 against the dealer's 10, nor do you need complex charts telling you in great detail how many times out of a thousand you will win or lose with this hand. All that you need to know is that with 16 against a 10 you hit. My aim is to show you clearly, concisely, and in easy-to-understand terms that You Can Win! I have worked in the casino industry for over ten years in Europe, on cruise ships, and in the United States, and have seen countless thousands of people lose their money across the tables (in some cases huge fortunes), all because of one main reason: The didn't know how to play! Their play was erratic and inconsistent. Sometimes they would hit 15 against the dealer's 9, sometimes they would stand. Sometimes they would double-down on 11 and sometimes not. They would automatically split pairs, most times without ever looking to see the dealer's up-card. Money management was almost nonexistent.
